**Haydn** is the composer who more than any other epitomizes the aims and achievements of the Classical era. We will explore the range and nature of his compositions by reference to a variety of masterworks from across the whole span of his career, with illustrations on excellent hi-fi equipment including DVD with large screen. We will conclude with a performance of his String Quartet Opus 74 No. 3, 'The Rider', at the public concert by the Endellion Quartet on Sunday afternoon, for which tickets are included.

Located in mature parkland and formerly the home of Prime Minister Lord North, **Dillington House** dates back to the 16th century and was remodelled in the early 19th century in the Jacobean style. It has the perfect combination of first class facilities and a peaceful and beautiful setting, including forty en-suite rooms.

**Terry Barfoot** writes widely on music for Britain's leading journals, orchestras, festivals and record companies. He lectures at venues throughout the country, is Publications Consultant to the Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra and the Director of Arts in Residence.
