Smetana was the first Czech composer to make an international impression, and his role as leader of the nationalist movement was hugely important to the development of the Czech musical tradition. He remains one of the most important opera composers of the nineteenth century, with a range of emotion that is both vivid and truthful. Our musical examples using CD and DVD will be played on excellent hi-fi equipment.

The Best Western **Wroxton House Hotel** is set in the beautiful thatched village of Wroxton. Dating in parts from 1649 and beautifully appointed, it is an idyllic retreat only 4 miles from Banbury, on the edge of the Cotswolds.
